Oath for Early Voting Ballot Board and Central Counting Station Personnel

Instructions: This oath should be administered verbally to all members of the early voting ballot board and all personnel at the central counting station prior to the performance of any duties by the

board or the central counting station.

For use in Primary Elections, General Election for State and County Officers, Elections ordered by the

Governor:

"I swear (or affirm) that I will objectively work to be sure every eligible voter's vote is accepted and

counted, and that only the ballots of those voters who violated the Texas Election Code will be rejected.

I will make every effort to correctly reflect the voter's intent when it can be clearly determined. I will not

work alone when ballots are present and will work only in the presence of a member of a political party

different from my own. I will faithfully perform my duty as an officer of the election and guard the purity

of the election."

For use in all Other Elections that do not contain Party Affiliation:

"I swear (or affirm) that I will objectively work to be sure every eligible voter's vote is accepted and

counted, and that only the ballots of those voters who violated the Texas Election Code will be rejected.

I will make every effort to correctly reflect the voter's intent when it can be clearly determined. I will not

work alone when ballots are present. I will faithfully perform my duty as an officer of the election and

guard the purity of the election."
