5:00 p.m. on the 78th day preceding General Election Day, except as provided by Section 146.025(b).

Secretary of State for statewide and district offices. County Judge for county and precinct offices.

Comments:

Candidates who file the declaration of write-in candidacy are subject to the requirements of reporting campaign contributions and expenditures.

The declaration of write-in candidacy shall be preserved for two years after the date of the election.

The declaration of write-in candidacy is public information immediately on its filing.

The declaration must be accompanied by a filing fee or a petition in lieu of a filing fee. Fees received with the declaration are to be deposited in the general revenue fund.
