

TRANSFERRED RULES

The Government Code, §2002.058, authorizes the Secretary of State to remove or transfer rules within the Texas Administrative Code when the agency that promulgated the rules is abolished. The Secretary of State will publish notice of rule transfer or removal in this section of the *Texas Register*. The effective date of a rule transfer is the date set by the legislature, not the date of publication of notice. Proposed or emergency rules are not subject to administrative transfer.

Rule Transfer

The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) is transferring 19 TAC Chapter 1, Subchapters T, U, V, W, X, Y, Z, and BB to 19 TAC Chapter 27, Subchapters A, B, C, D, E, F, G, and H. The administrative transfer will allow THECB to organize its chapters according to subject matter and does not affect the content of the rules.

New Chapter 27 will deal exclusively with Fields of Study and subchapters concerned with Field of Study Advisory Committees will be added in the future.

The transfer takes effect September 1, 2016.
